NCPO's Road Map

First Phase:

The first phase will involve efforts to achieve national reconciliation as soon as possible, within 2-3 months. In addition to security operations, Center of Reconciliation for Reform will be established for central and rural reforms paving way to the second phase. We will begin in all areas starting from small units, families, and move to villages, sub-districts, districts, provinces. NCPO has assigned the Internal Security Operations Command (ISOC) to be the responsible unit in holding dialogues between all sides to ensure successful second phase. Preparatory committee will also be set up to pave way for the confrontation free second phase. There are no restructuring of any agencies, request for monetary payment, or amnesties.

Second Phase:

Enactment of interim Constitution which is being drafted by the legal team. Legislative Assembly will be established an interim Government will be appointed for state administration, and drafting of the Constitution will soon begin. A National Reform Assembly will also be set up to initiate reform. The second phase should take more or less one year depending on the situation. If the situation returns to normal, and successful reform and national reconciliation and unity have been achieved, we will, then, move to the third and final phase.

Third Phase:

A general election under the democratic system which is legal and accepted by all sides. Our country will have a good and just leader.
