NOTIFICATION OF THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE

on Determination of Municipal Waste as Prohibited Goods from Being Imported into  
and from Being Brought in Transit through the Kingdom

B.E. 2562 (2019)

Whereas, it is necessary for environmental preservation, public health and public safety, it is deemed appropriate to prescribe municipal waste as prohibited goods from being imported into and from being brought in transit through the Kingdom.

By virtue of the provisions of Section 5, paragraph one (1), of Export and Import of Goods Act, B.E. 2522 (1979), and Section 5/1 of Export and Import of Goods Act, B.E. 2522 (1979), as amended by Export and Import of Goods Act (No. 2), B.E. 2558 (2015), Minister of Commerce, by and with approval of the Council of Ministers, hereby issues this Notification, as follows:

Clause 1 This Notification shall be called “Notification of the Ministry of Commerce on Determination of Municipal Waste as Prohibited Goods from Being Imported into and from Being Brought in Transit through the Kingdom B.E. 2562 (2019)”

Clause 2 This Notification shall come into force upon a lapse of thirty days from the date of its publication in the Government Gazette.

Clause 3 Municipal waste of the Customs HS code 3825.10.00 shall be prohibited goods from being imported into and from being brought in transit through the Kingdom.
